Our annual "Improving Practice/Patient experience" survey

The Practice recognises that 'appointment availability and telephone access' continue to be areas of concern. We would like to assure everyone that we are actively working towards recruiting extra GP's (despite the national shortage) and we are reviewing various aspects of our telephone system with the aim of making it easier for patients when ringing the surgery. We are also boosting the number of staff available to help with the high volume of incoming calls. In addition the responses to the survey are being discussed with the Patient Participation Group

There is no need to contact us to obtain your results. Once the GP who asked for the test to be done has viewed them the patient concerned will be contacted if any follow-up action is required

Our online services

Patients with access to the internet are encouraged to register to use our online services to book appointments online; order repeat prescriptions and view certain elements of their own patient record. It is easy to register; simply call into reception with photo ID and proof of address. You will then be asked to complete a request form after which a unique user ID and password will be issued. (So far 1,010 of our patients have registered to use our online services)
