

Points to bear in mind about appointments

- A. 'Same Day' appointments are classed as urgent appointments. If you do not consider that you need an urgent appointment please opt for a prebookable appointment instead
- B. Same Day appointments will normally be booked with one of our Nurse Practitioners who are experienced in a wide range of ailments and conditions
- C. Each Nurse Practitioner has the facility to transfer patients across to the Duty Doctor on the day if necessary
- D. Patients wishing to see a GP have the option to pre-book an appointment for a different day –subject to availability
- E. The reception team have to follow strict guidelines (which have been put in place by Dr Tew/Dr Clarke) to cover the specific ailments which must be dealt with by the Duty Doctor on the day rather than a Nurse Practitioner –Everything else 'on the day' will usually be booked with a Nurse Practitioner
- F. Other than the Duty Doctor all of the other GP's will be seeing patients who have pre-booked an appointment with them
- G. Monday/Tuesday evening appointments are available 2 weeks ahead specifically for patients who are at work during the day so at the time of booking, the reception staff will need to ask for the patient's occupation (This is simply to ensure that these appointments are used solely by patients who are at work in the daytime)
- H. Our ten minute appointments are normally for one problem only (at the discretion of the person the appointment is with)

Next PPG meeting

The next PPG meeting: is due to take place on Tuesday 16th February 2016 at 12.15pm

Appointments

Following a number of changes to our appointment systems over the last few months we are pleased to advise that we have now introduced a simpler system for everyone which we anticipate will improve the patient experience. These changes are summarised below.

1. Prebookable appointments can now be booked from [8am](#) (instead of patients having to wait until [11am](#) to pre-book)
2. We have increased the amount of GP prebookable appointments for all GPs (including Dr Clarke and Dr Tew).
3. Evening appointments on Mondays and Tuesday's can now be booked up to 2 weeks ahead rather than just 2 days in advance (These appointments are solely for patients who work during the day).
4. Our telephone system has been changed to make it easier when ringing to book an appointment with fewer caller options to choose from and less automated messages.
5. Our incoming phone lines have been increased and calls at our busiest times are now being spread across all of our experienced staff
6. Methods of booking appointments have also been simplified as summarised below

Appointments can be booked:

- ◇ Over the telephone OR
- ◇ By visiting the surgery OR
- ◇ Online via the Practice website (if already registered to use this option)
- **Same Day appointments** will usually be with a Nurse Practitioner who can liaise with the Duty Doctor when necessary
- **Pre-bookable GP appointments** can now be booked :
 - ◇ 2 days in advance (for [Monday-Friday](#) day-time appointments)
 - ◇ 2 weeks in advance for appointments on Saturday mornings
 - ◇ 2 weeks in advance for Mon/Tues evenings –These appointments are specifically for those patients who work during the day
